


Dear Parents and Carers,

Progress on the new school building is rapid and we are very much looking forward to occupying the site on Stoke Road, Slough, in September 2016.

The map below shows where Lynch Hill Enterprise Academy will be located:



As you can imagine, packing every item in our current school, in preparation for the move over the summer, will be an enormous task. The **end of term** for students will therefore begin at **1.30pm on Thursday, 14<sup>th</sup> July 2016**. This is one day earlier than the previously published date but is necessary because all ICT facilities, furniture and books need to be packed for moving by the morning of Friday, 15<sup>th</sup> July 2016.

**Term will begin for Year 8 and 9 students at 8.30am on Thursday, 8<sup>th</sup> September 2016**. The start of term for new Year 7 students will be at 8.30am on Wednesday, 7<sup>th</sup> September 2016.

I would be most grateful if you could ensure your son or daughter arrives in full uniform with all equipment (including a black pen, a green pen, pencil, ruler and calculator) on the first day of term.

I would like to advise you that there will not be any onsite parking for parents, and off-road parking is very limited. If you have any questions or queries regarding transport, please contact Mrs Coffey at Lynch Hill Primary School Academy.
