Please note, a member of staff opens the school gate at 8:00am each morning. Students are not permitted entry onto the school site before this time.

Car Parking

We realise parking is difficult outside the school and we ask that parents park considerately both in the morning and after school to ensure the safety of our children and out of respect to our local residents.

Please do not:

- Park across the drives of our local residents' houses.
- Park in front of the school gates at any time during the school day to drop children off. This poses a danger to children who may be walking behind reversing vehicles. In addition, this access point must be kept clear in the event of an emergency.
- The schools site team place cones along the pavement, outside of the school, specifically to stop cars parking inconsiderately on the pavement. As part of the school's travel plan we would encourage parents and children to walk to school whenever possible. On the occasions when you must use a car we suggest you park away from the school. (Along Lismore Park and cross at the island crossing).

We ask that you support these important safety guidelines as we continue to ensure the area around our school is safe for your children.
