Dear Parents and Carers,

I have very much enjoyed my first term as the Headteacher of Lynch Hill Enterprise Academy and I have seen our students grow and develop over this term. I should like to congratulate the children and staff who have worked so tirelessly and successfully this year and I wish them all a happy and restful summer holiday.

Similarly, I enjoyed meeting our new year 7 intake recently and, along with the excellent new staff members that I have appointed as we continue our growth as a school, I look forward to welcoming our new year group in September.
